- Isa 64:7 No one calls on your name or strives to lay hold of you; for you have hidden your face from us and made us waste away because of our sins.
- Jer 5:1-2 Go up and down the streets of Jerusalem, look around and consider, search through her squares. If you can find but one person who deals honestly and seeks the truth, I will forgive this city. ²Although they say, 'As surely as the LORD lives,' still they are swearing falsely."
- Job 15:14-16 "What is man, that he could be pure, or one born of woman, that he could be righteous? ¹⁵If God places no trust in his holy ones, if even the heavens are not pure in his eyes, ¹⁶how much less man, who is vile and corrupt, who drinks up evil like water!
- Ps 36:1-4 An oracle is within my heart concerning the sinfulness of the wicked: There is no fear of God before his eyes. ²For in his own eyes he flatters himself too much to detect or hate his sin. ³The words of his mouth are wicked and deceitful; he has ceased to be wise and to do good. ⁴Even on his bed he plots evil; he commits himself to a sinful course and does not reject what is wrong.
- (Pr 19:3 A man's own folly ruins his life, yet his heart rages against the LORD.)
- Ps 51:5 Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me.
- Ps 143:2 Do not bring your servant into judgment, for no one living is righteous before you.

The sin nature

- Gal 5:16-17 So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. ¹⁷For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, so that you do not do what you want.
- Rom 7:14-25 We know that the law is spiritual; but I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin. ¹⁵I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. ¹⁶And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good. ¹⁷As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. ¹⁸I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out. 19For what I do is not the good I want to do; no, the evil I do not want to do-this I keep on doing. ²⁰Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in me that does it. ²¹So I find this law at work: When I want to do good, evil is right there with me. ²²For in my inner being I delight in God's law; ²³but I see another law at work in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within my members. ²⁴What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? ²⁵Thanks be to God-through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in the sinful nature a slave to the law of sin.
- Gal 5:19-21 The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; ²⁰idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions ²¹and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.
- Rom 8:5-8 Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. ⁶The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace; ⁷the sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. ⁸Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God.
- Gal 6:8a The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction:
- Eph 2:3 All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our sinful nature and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature objects of wrath.
- Jam 1:14-15 but each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire, he is dragged away and enticed. ¹⁵Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.
- Mt 26:41 "Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak."

Due to the fall

- Rom 5:12 Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned-
- Rom 5:18a Consequently, just as the result of one trespass was condemnation for all men.
- Rom 5:19a For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners,

God's view

- Rom 3:9-18 What shall we conclude then? Are we any better? Not at all! We have already made the charge that Jews and Gentiles alike are all under sin.

 10 As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one; 11 there is no one who understands, no one who seeks God. 12 All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good, not even one." 13 "Their throats are open graves; their tongues practice deceit."

 "The poison of vipers is on their lips." 14 "Their mouths are full of cursing and bitterness." 15 "Their feet are swift to shed blood; 16 ruin and misery mark their ways, 17 and the way of peace they do not know." 18 "There is no fear of God before their eyes."
- Gen 6:5 The LORD saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil all the time.
- Gen 6:11-12 Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight and was full of violence. ¹²God saw how corrupt the earth had become, for all the people on earth had corrupted their ways.
- Gen 8:21b "Never again will I curse the ground because of man, even though every inclination of his heart is evil from childhood.
- Isa 48:8 You have neither heard nor understood; from of old your ear has not been open. Well do I know how treacherous you are; you were called a rebel from birth.
- Jer 16:12 But you have behaved more wickedly than your fathers. See how each of you is following the stubbornness of his evil heart instead of obeying me.
- Jer 17:9 The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?
- Mt 7:11a If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children,
- Jn 2:24-25 But Jesus would not entrust himself to them, for he knew all men. ²⁵He did not need man's testimony about man, for he knew what was in a man.
