One plan/one way

- Jn 3:3 In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again."
- Jn 3:36 Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him."
- Rom 10:9-10 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.
- (Jn 8:24 I told you that you would die in your sins; if you do not believe that I am [the one I claim to be], you will indeed die in your sins.")
- 1Jn 5:10-12 Anyone who believes in the Son of God has this testimony in his heart. Anyone who does not believe God has made him out to be a liar, because he has not believed the testimony God has given about his Son. ¹¹And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. ¹²He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.
- Jn 6:44 "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day.
- Jn 6:65 He went on to say, "This is why I told you that no one can come to me unless the Father has enabled him."
- Jn 10:1 "I tell you the truth, the man who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in by some other way, is a thief and a robber.

Through One only

- Isa 45:22 "Turn to me and be saved, all you ends of the earth; for I am God, and there is no other.
- Mt 7:13-14 "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. ¹⁴But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.
- Jn 10:7, 9a Therefore Jesus said again, "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep. ... ⁹I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved.

- Jn 10:16 I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. They too will listen to my voice, and there shall be one flock and one shepherd.
- Jn 14:6 Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.
- Jn 17:3 Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.
- Jn 20:31 But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
- Jn 6:68-69 Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. ⁶⁹We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God."
- Jn 1:14b We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only,
 Jn 1:18 No one has ever seen God, but God the One and Only, who is at the Father's side, has made him known.
- Jn 5:44 How can you believe if you accept praise from one another, yet make no effort to obtain the praise that comes from the only God?
- Jn 8:12 When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."
- Jn 11:25-26 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; ²⁶and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?"
- Act 4:12 Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved."
- Mt 12:30 "He who is not with me is against me, and he who does not gather with me scatters.
- Rom 5:9 Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him!
- Rom 5:11 Not only is this so, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.
- 1Co 3:11 For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.
- 1Co 8:6 yet for us there is but one God, the Father, from whom all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live.
- 1Co 15:21-22 For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. ²²For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.
- Phl 2:9-11 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- Rom 3:29-30 Is God the God of Jews only? Is he not the God of Gentiles too? Yes, of Gentiles too, ³⁰since there is only one God, who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised through that same faith.
- 1Ti 2:5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,
 Eph 3:12 In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence.
 Heb 7:25a Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him,
 1Pe 1:21 Through him you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, and so your faith and hope are in God.
- 1Jn 2:1 My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense-Jesus Christ, the Righteous One.
 1Jn 2:12 I write to you, dear children, because your sins have been forgiven on account of his name.

God's terms

- Job 34:33a Should God then reward you on your terms, when you refuse to repent?
- Rom 9:20 But who are you, O man, to talk back to God? "Shall what is formed say to him who formed it, 'Why did you make me like this?'"
- Rev 22:18-19 I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book. ¹⁹And if anyone takes words away from this book of prophecy, God will take away from him his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book.
- Dt 4:2 Do not add to what I command you and do not subtract from it, but keep the commands of the LORD your God that I give you.
- Dt 12:32 See that you do all I command you; do not add to it or take away from it.
- Pr 30:6 Do not add to his words, or he will rebuke you and prove you a liar.
- Ecc 12:11-12a The words of the wise are like goads, their collected sayings like firmly embedded nails-given by one Shepherd. ¹²Be warned, my son, of anything in addition to them.
- Mt 4:9-10 "All this I will give you," he said, "if you will bow down and worship me." ¹⁰Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'"
- Dt 6:13-14 Fear the LORD your God, serve him only and take your oaths in his name. ¹⁴Do not follow other gods, the gods of the peoples around you;
- Rom 1:20 For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities-his eternal power and divine nature-have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.
- Lk 3:6 And all mankind will see God's salvation."
- Heb 2:3-4 how shall we escape if we ignore such a great salvation? This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him. ⁴God also testified to it by signs, wonders and various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.
- 1Co 15:1-2 Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. ²By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.
- Heb 3:19 So we see that they were not able to enter, because of their unbelief.
- Heb 4:6 It still remains that some will enter that rest, and those who formerly had the gospel preached to them did not go in, because of their disobedience.
- Mk 10:15 I tell you the truth, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it."
- Mk 10:17-24 As Jesus started on his way, a man ran up to him and fell on his knees before him. "Good teacher," he asked, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?" ¹⁸"Why do you call me good?" Jesus answered. "No one is good-except God alone. ¹⁹You know the commandments: 'Do not murder, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not give false testimony, do not defraud, honor your father and mother.'" ²⁰"Teacher," he declared, "all these I have kept since I was a boy." ²¹Jesus looked at him and loved him. "One thing you lack," he said. "Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." ²²At this the man's face fell. He went away sad, because he had great wealth. ²³Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God!" ²⁴The disciples were amazed at his words. But Jesus said again, "Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God!
